*Short title and commencement.*— (1) The scheme shall be called “subsidy for custom service in agriculture”.

The above referred notification is amended as below.

Clause 3: **Eligibility of farmers** at (i) is replaced and shall be read as:—

(i) All the farmers in Goa venturing for cultivation/harvesting/transplanting shall be eligible for subsidy on hire charges of Agricultural Machineries.

Clause 5: **General Guidelines & procedure** at (vi) is replaced and shall be read as under:—

(vi) 50% subsidy under custom service for harvesting of paddy using paddy combine as per the original notified scheme published in Official Gazette under Notification No. 3/1/WS/Mech/13-14/ /D.Agr./224 of Series I No. 16 dated 18th July, 2013 is reinstated from Kharif 2015-16.

Other contents of the Notification remains the same.

This amendment will be effective from Kharif Harvest 2015 onwards. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance (Expenditure) Department, Government of Goa vide U. O. 3245/F dated 19-10-2015.

The following draft rules which the Government of Goa proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 112 of the Factories Act, 1948 (Central Act No. 63 of 1948) (hereinafter referred to as the “said Act”), so as to amend the Goa Factories (Occupational Safety and Health Audit) Rules, 2014 are hereby pre-published as required by section 115 of the said Act, for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft rules shall be taken into consideration by the Government after the expiry of a period of forty-five days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.

All objections and suggestions to the said draft rules may be forwarded to the Secretary (Factories and Boilers), Government of Goa, Secretariat, Porvorim, before the expiry of the said period of forty-five days, so that they may be taken into consideration at the time of finalization of the said rules.

**DRAFT RULES**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 112 of the Factories Act, 1948 (Central Act No. 63 of 1948), and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to amend the Goa Factories (Occupational Safety and Health Audit) Rules, 2014, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement* — (1) These rules may be called the Goa Factories (Occupational Safety and Health Audit) (First Amendment) Rules, 2015.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Amendment of rule 1.*— In rule 1 of the Goa Factories (Occupational Safety and Health Audit) Rules, 2014, in sub-rule (2), for the expression “valid OHSAS (18001:2007) certificate”, the expression “valid certificate for occupational health and safety management system issued by a certification

body accredited to National Accreditation Board for Certification Bodies (NABCB) formed by the Quality Council of India under the administrative control of the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India” shall be substituted.

(d) Applicant seeking financial assistance for the re-construction of house shall produce the house tax receipt on his own name or irrevocable NOC from the house owner, Form I & XIV and declaration of the relationship of the family member whose name is reflected in Form I & XIV.

(e) Applicant seeking financial assistance for the repairs of house shall produce the house tax receipt on his own name or irrevocable NOC from the house owner.

The Government of Goa is pleased to revise and modify the scheme of Infrastructure Development in Tribal Area under Tribal sub-plan, viz. "Adivasi Vikas Yojana" read above, as under:—

(j) In sub-clause (j) of clause 15, after item (d) the following item shall be added:—

"(e) In case of submission of utilization certificate of 1st installment along with the completion certificate for the project, the balance amount of the project may be released in one installment by Director of Tribal Welfare."

(ii) In clause 15 after sub-clause (vi), the following sub-clause shall be added,—

(vii) In case of the project is executed by a Government agency, viz. Public Works Department, Electricity Department, Forest Department, Water Resources Department, Directorate of Agriculture or any other Government Department then the sanction and allotment of funds shall be done in the following manner:—

(a) Upon submission of the complete set of tender bid details and before issue of work order by the Government Executing agency, the Director of Tribal Welfare shall allot 25% of the finalized tendered amount (including all charged), to the Executive Engineer of

the Division concerned/Drawing and Disbursing Officer of the Government executing agency.

(b) The allotment of funds shall be subject to the Director of Tribal Welfare obtaining prior concurrence of Finance (Expenditure) Department for executing the work of the said project.

(c) The initial allotment of funds order issued by the Director of Tribal Welfare shall be deemed to be the expenditure sanction for the project concerned and thereafter, the Government executing agency concerned shall issue the work order for the project.

(d) Upon utilizing the funds allotted, the Government executing agency, shall submit the progress report for the project along with photographs etc., and thereafter Director of Tribal Welfare shall release additional amount as requested by the Government executing agency from time to time.

(e) No revision in cost of the project shall be permitted.
