Whereas the Government has notified a scheme "Scheme to support Orphan child/children of widow belonging to ST Community" vide Notification No. DTW/STAT/PC/2012-13/64 in Official Gazette, Series I No. 29 dated 18-10-2012 amended vide Notification No. DTW/STAT/PC/2013-14/64/9719 notified in Official Gazette, Series I No. 48 dated 27-02-2014 and further amended vide notification No. DTW/SAT/PC/2020-21/64/85 dated 29-04-2020 notified in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 6 dated 07-05-2020.

And whereas Government desires to amend Clause 3, 4 & add new Clause 5 and delete Clause 7 of the "Scheme to support Orphan child/children of Widow belonging to ST Community" in public interest.

Now therefore, the Clause 3 & 4 of the scheme is amended to read as under:—

3. *Benefit under the Scheme.*— (A) Fixed maintenance allowances of Rs. 2500/- per month, per child of a widow.

(B) Fixed maintenance allowances of Rs. 3000/- per month, per child who is an orphan.

4. *Eligibility.*— (1) Any widow belonging to ST Community/non ST community married to ST and having minor children belonging to ST community is eligible, subject to the benefit being limited to 2 children up to the age of 18 years.

(2) Any orphan belonging to ST Community who is under the care of a guardian, viz.,

grandparents of near relatives or in a protective home/Dharmasala etc. up to the age of 18 years.

(3) In case of Children of widow, Family income of the widow should not exceed Rs. 3,00,000/- per annum.

(4) In case of Orphan children there is no Income criteria.

New Clause 5 is added to the scheme "Scheme to support orphan child/children of Widow belonging to ST Community" which is read as under.

5. *Requirement of documents.*— a) Following documents shall be attached with application form of Children of Widow Scheme:

1. Marriage certificate of the applicant.

2. Birth certificate of child/children.

3. Death certificate of husband of the applicant.

4. Scheduled Tribe certificate of applicant/husband and children issued by competent authority.

5. Aadhaar card of applicant & beneficiary.

6. Family Income certificate issued by competent authority.

7. Mandate form/Joint account of beneficiary.

Applicant shall submit the life certificate in the month of April every year. Life certificate is valid for a period of one year from the date of issue.

b) Following documents shall be attached with application form of

Scheme to support Orphan Child belonging to Scheduled Tribe Community."

1. Birth certificate of orphan child.

2. Death certificate of father & mother of orphan child.

3. Scheduled Tribe certificate of the orphan child issued by competent authority.

4. Copy of the Ration Card/Election Card of the Guardian.
5. Affidavit of the Guardian.
6. Aadhar Card of applicant & beneficiary.
7. Mandate form/Joint account of beneficiary.

Applicant shall submit the life certificate in the month of April every year. Life certificate is valid for a period of one year from the date of issue.

If any widow belonging to Scheduled Tribe or any other community, having minor Scheduled Tribe child/children & do not possess Marriage certificate issued by competent authority then Birth certificate of ST child/children issued by competent authority shall be submitted instead of Marriage Certificate.

Existing Clause 7 Evaluation of the scheme: deleted.

Hence Clause 5 may be read as Clause 6, Clause 6 may be read as Clause 7.

All other clauses in the above mentioned scheme remains unchanged. This amendment shall come in to force from the date of the publication of Notification on Official Gazette.

In exercise of powers conferred by sections 33 of Goa Irrigation Act, 1973 (Act No. 18 of 1973) read with section 21 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 (Central Act No. 10 of 1897), the Government of Goa hereby amends the Government Notification No. 309/83/CE-IRRG, dated 01-02-1988, published in the Official Gazette, Series III No. 46 dated 11-02-1988

(hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Notification") for the purpose of water drawn by/supplied to Public Works Department, Government of Goa as per below:—

1) *Clause B in the Principal Notification shall be substituted as below:—*

B. Water rates for water drawn from a canal or an irrigation structure or a scheme constructed and maintained by the Government for the purpose other than irrigation, including domestic, commercial or industrial, shall be as under:—

(a) A flat rate of Rs. 120/- for every 10,000 litres of water drawn or part thereof shall be levied for the units at Verna Industrial Estate.

(b) A flat rate of Rs. 100/- for every 10,000 litres of water drawn/supplied or part thereof shall be levied to Public Works Department, Government of Goa. This rate shall be retrospectively applicable from 01-08-2021 onwards.

(c) For all other purposes, a flat rate of Rs. 200/- for every 10,000 litres of water drawn or part thereof shall be levied. The person/s or entity/ies drawing water shall make own arrangement to draw the water and also for measurement of flow.

The clause (a) above is subject to the following conditions:

(i) It shall be effective from 01-11-2020.

(ii) The rates shall exclusively be applicable to the units in the Verna Industrial Estate.

(iii) The rates shall be increased by 10% every two years with first revision effective from 01-04-2022.

(iv) The rate is applicable to only those units who shall clear their outstanding dues either in instalment or in lump sum before 31-03-2021.

2) *Clause C in the Principal Notification shall be substituted as below:—*

C. (i) Water rates for water drawn from any canal other than the one constructed

Whereas the Government has notified a scheme "Scheme to support Orphan child/children of Widow belonging to ST Community" vide Notification No. DTW/STAT/PC/2012-13/64 notified in Official Gazette Series I No. 29 dated 18-10-2012 and the same has been revised vide Notification No. DTW/STAT/PC/2013-14/64/9719 notified in Official Gazette Series I No. 48 dated 27-02-2014.

And whereas Government desires to amend Clause 4, Clause 5 and Clause 7 of the scheme "Scheme to support Orphan child/children of Widow belonging to ST Community" in public interest.

Now therefore, the Clause 4, Clause 5 and Clause 7 of the scheme of "Scheme to support Orphan child/children of Widow belonging to ST Community" is amended to read as under:—

4. **Eligibility.**— (1) Any widow belonging to ST Community and having minor children is eligible, subject to the benefit being limited to 2 children upto the age of 18 years.

(2) Any orphan belonging to ST Community who is under the care of a guardian, viz, grandparents of near relatives or in a protective home/Dharmasala etc. upto the age of 18 years.

(3) Any widow belonging to non ST Community but having minor children eligible belonging to ST Community, subject to the benefit being limited to 2 children upto the age of 18 years.

(4) In case of Children of widow, Income of the widow should not exceed Rs. 3,00,000/- per annum.

(5) In case of Orphan children, there is no income criteria.

5. *Application procedures and Sanctioning Authority.*— (A) For availing the benefits under the scheme, any widow belonging to ST Community/Non ST community having minor children belonging to ST community may apply in prescribed Application Form (Annexure A) to the Directorate of Tribal Welfare.

Director of Tribal Welfare will sanction the amount of benefit under the scheme and will release the amount to the beneficiary in the joint account of child and mother.

7. *"Evaluation of the scheme.*— Scheme will be implemented from 27-02-2019 till further three years. Performance of the scheme will be evaluated after two years of its implementation and if required, scheme will be suitably modified to meet the new challenges/requirements so as to achieve the set objective."

All other clauses in the above mentioned scheme remains unchanged.

This amendment shall come in to force from date of the publication of Notification.

Now therefore, Clause 10 of the scheme of "Pre-Primary for Scheduled Tribes children in Remote Areas" is amended to read as under:—

Clause 10: Evaluation of the Scheme:

Scheme namely "Pre-Primary for Scheduled Tribes children in Remote Areas" for the period of five years i.e. 17-09-2023. Performance of the scheme will be evaluated after two years of its implementation and if required scheme will be suitably modified to meet the new challenges/requirements so as to achieve the set objective.

All other clause in the above mentioned scheme remains unchanged.
